

COVID-19 Safety Protocols

Updated 03.01.2022

Effective March 1, 2022, AmerisourceBergen's mask requirements for U.S. locations, meetings, events, and conventions will be aligned with the CDC's latest guidance on COVID-19 levels in the community, designated by red, yellow or green status. The following mask guidance is in effect regardless of vaccination status:

- Masks are **required** indoors when the county status is red.
- Masks are **optional** indoors when the county status is green or yellow.
- Attendees may continue to wear a mask at any time. Anyone with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask in accordance with [CDC guidelines](#).

Masks will continue to be available on-site at AB-hosted meetings and where we have a convention presence in support of personal levels of comfort.

- Masks must continue to be worn in healthcare settings, at patient care facilities and at certain locations based on that location's mask requirements, where required by local jurisdiction or in instances where mask requirements are more stringent than AB or CDC guidance.
- Team members conducting business travel must continue to wear a mask in airports, on airplanes, and on public transportation in alignment with federal, state, and common carrier policies
- This mask guidance is subject to change at any point based on a number of factors and with little notice. Refer to onsite and pre-event communications for the latest mask requirements.

At this time, **there are no additional COVID-19 protocols in place** to attend an AB-hosted event or attend a convention, unless otherwise specified.

For the Securos University wet labs in 2022, Securos supplies personal protective equipment (PPE) for every attendee, faculty member, and support staff in attendance. For additional protection this year, Securos has added face shields and surgical aprons to our PPE supplies. We've also booked additional space for each event to accommodate social distancing guidelines and minimize unnecessary contact with fellow wet lab attendees. In addition, Securos has eliminated shared resource tables by upgrading each attendee's workshop table with assigned resources and more surgical space. As a final measure to reduce potential cross contamination, Securos will offer all PowerPoint notes and surveys in a digital format and only offer printed material upon request. As it pertains to our Securos University Wet Labs in 2022, we will keep attendees informed of any update, changes, or adjustments that may arise as the COVID-19 situation evolves.
